COMBINED PERMITS allow Legal Concealed Carry in: MT, ID, UT, AZ, SD, NE, OK, IA, MO, IN, KY, TN, NC, VT, MI, WY, WA, ND, TX, MN, AR, LA, WI, MS, AL, OH, WV, PA, VA, NC, GA, DE.

All Classes are held at the Timbers Restaurant in Toledo and begin at 9:00 a.m. unless otherwise specified. Preregistration is required. No "Walk-Ins". Deadline to register is the Friday before the course date or by permission of Instructor.

FEE: Oregon - \$60, Utah - \$100 (Cash, Check or Money Order only). Fees do not include application to obtain Permit or License. You must be legally able to own a firearm in the United States.
