The guns were a couple of 1903 Springfields, a Original Trap Door Springfield in 45/70, a scoped 1917 Enfield, a Savage 340 in 30/30, as well as a NEF in 356, and a Smith and Wesson 41 mag revolver, an AR15 and a Ruger Scout. The two top shooters were scoped rifles a Ruger Scout in 308 and a scoped AR15. Both of these shooters shot a score of 38 out of 40 and the winner is the Ruger Scout Rifle who shot 10 out of 10 Rams as the AR went 9 for 10 in the Ram count. The rest of the scores were in the high 20's and one 30.
