PISTOL RANGE UPDATE – Hopefully we’ll get the shooting bench built during Septembers work party. We also hope to have the metal roof on by then.

On another note – There was a theft of building materials at the range recently. Several 2”x 6” boards for use on the pistol range shooting shelter were stolen. It is assumed the theft was by a member, or someone else who somehow gained access to the range to haul the material off. *An anonymous member who heard about the theft donated personal funds to replace the stolen boards so we could finish the roof. **Thank You sir!***

I was wondering how long it was going to take before some *low-life* was going to **steal** some of the building materials from the club. So, whoever you are, **thief**, you’ve forced the club to do something it shouldn’t have to do, which is, install security cameras.

The Lincoln County Sheriff’s Office has offered to install security cameras at the range. A motion to ask the Lincoln County Sheriff’s Office to install security cameras at the range was made, seconded, and passed on a voice vote.

So here’s the deal – anyone caught damaging and/or stealing, or found out after to have damaged and/or stolen club property, with or without security camera footage, will be identified to the Sheriffs Office for arrest and prosecution.

The National Shooting Sports Foundation grant has been applied for, we’ll know if we are to receive it by the end of September. The value of the steel target sets is \$2100–\$2200. If we receive them, we are obligated to put on four NSSF shoots per year. *Calling for volunteers. It would be a great way to work off your work bond.*

Help take care of the range. On the rifle and pistol range, after you are done shooting **please** recover your targets and target stands. If the target stand is no longer serviceable put the wood and debris on the burn pile or in a trash barrel. On the pistol range after you are done shooting if there is a noticeable impact furrow in the gravel fill it back in. We will re-compact the pistol range this fall after a couple of rains settle the gravel but in the mean time please fill in the furrows.

Here’s what happened on the OSP schedule screw up. The OSP OIC went on leave for an extended period of time. He thought the BTRPC/OSP agreement was complete and had approved a qualification date for August (by that, he told me that he thought the date had been coordinated or was going to be coordinated with BTRPC, i.e. me), his trainer thought the date was good, so OSP went to the range and did their qualification, and I didn’t know a thing about it until I received a couple of phone calls from BTRPC members about not being able to get on the range. I talked to the OSP OIC Lt. McGladery and he apologized for the lack of coordination. I have to take part of that hit because I should have stayed closer in touch with OSP since we were just getting our relationship started. So - to the guys that called me and John Way about not being able to get on the range - **Sorry for the mix up.** Fix is - I’ll be meeting with Lt. McGladery next week to get their yearly training dates and range preference so we won’t have anymore schedule issues, at least with OSP.

The club won a handgun at the Friends of the NRA Banquet on August 1st. We will be raffling it off as this year’s Christmas raffle. It is a Heritage Manufacturing Rough Rider 22 LR/22 WMR, 6.5” combo revolver with NRA lettering on the grip panel. The gun is at Wesley’s on display. Tickets are \$1 each, or 6 for \$5. Maximum tickets to be sold is 1,000. The drawing will be held at the December Membership meeting on December 21st.

What do you think? We need to plan for the next grant, or grants. Options discussed so far are; parking improvements, the carbine range (next to the pistol range – same type of building) and finishing the electrical.
