**WE'RE STILL GETTING CALLS...AFTER HOURS SHOOTING ON ALL RANGES MUST STOP!**

The range closes at 8:00pm (range rule #16). There is no shooting allowed after 8:00pm on any of the ranges. The board members get calls from the neighbors every time someone continues shooting past 8:00pm. We have regular security patrols at the range that will be stepped up around closing time. Personnel will be asked to observe and report any live fire activities after 8:00pm. Your membership may be revoked without refund for breaking any of the range rules.

- **ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP DUES AND KEY CHANGE** - It's time to pay our annual dues and change the gate locks again. We are changing the locks a little later this year, probably around the second week of July, as we are getting new locks with a blank that only we will have access to. If you signed up or paid your annual dues at Wesley's Trading Post, you will return to Wesley's with the card he gave you to receive your new keys.
