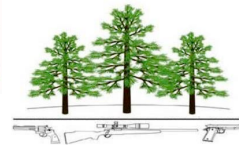

MEMBERSHIP DUES – The 2017-18 membership year began in June and the gate lock has been changed. We are revising the prorated and there will *only* be 12-month and 6-month membership options. Stay tuned for more info.

WORK BOND – The work bond is a commitment made by individual members as part of their annual dues to work for 4 hours within the current membership year. Work can be in the form of general maintenance, work parties, range improvement project, or supporting a club event.
