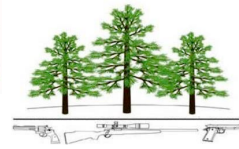

NEW CLUB DUES - Effective June 2019-2020 year, BTRPC club dues will be \$100 plus \$5 for the gate key. The board will be discussing a pro-rate schedule before the 2019-20 year.

APRIL BOARD MEETING – The following motions were made and passed:

- **PRORATION OF DUES** - Effective June 2019, dues will be prorated for new members only from January 1 to June 30 at a rate of \$55. Renewal members pay the full annual rate regardless of when they pay their renewal.
- Remove BTRPC Rule #15 concerning concealed firearms.
- Add a rule banning the discharge of .50 BMG firearms.
- Remove the section on the Work Bond beginning with the 2019-2020 membership year.
- Issue only one key per membership application, with exceptions heard by the Board of Directors on case by case basis at a regular meeting.
- Charge \$10 for any additional keys the Board of Directors approve.
- Increase the fee for mailing the newsletter to \$7 annually.
- Confirm BTRPC acting officers, Walt Heller as Vice President and Bill Henderson as Member-at-Large.

CLUB OFFICERS NOMINATIONS – May and June are nomination months for club officers for the 2019 – 2020 membership year.

RULE REITERATION – No rifles, shotguns, or pistols chambered for rifle or shotgun rounds, may be discharged at the pistol range. These do way too much damage to the berm.

THANKS to Jim Patrick for patching the hole in the pistol range roof.

SUMMERFEST – The SUMMERFEST raffle rifle, and the raffle knife (custom made by Walt Heller) are on display at Wesley’s Trading Post. Tickets are \$ each, or 6 for \$5. There is a limit of 1100 tickets to be sold, better get them early. The rifle is Mossberg Patriot chambered in 6.5 Creedmoor with a 3x9 Leupold VX-II scope mounted.

STEEL GONG MATCH – Steel Gong Benchrest Matches will be on the 3rd Saturday of May, June and July. 200, 300, 385 and 500 meter gongs of around 2 minutes will definitely sort out the sharpshooters. 10 shots at each range with sighters. \$5 entry fee, starts at 9:00 a.m. Contact Dave Boyce or Dan Geisert at (971) 241-8658.
