ANTI-GUN LEGISLATION – OK, so it looks like SB 978 is dead thanks to the Republican Senators taking a stand and denying a quorum for any legislation for about a week, that got enough peoples attention that folks started talking – good. However do not think for one moment the Democrats anti-gun efforts are finished, they are not, they are just re-grouping for another charge. Anti-gun Senator Ginny Burdick promised that anti-gun bills would fail "over my dead body" and I'm pretty sure she is still with us, so be aware and do not think that this is over. The 2019 legislature still has about four weeks to go and a lot can happen in that time.

<u>SAFETY</u> - For those of you who will be renewing your membership in June and for anyone joining, you will be/should be reading the <u>General Membership Rules</u>, <u>Range Rules</u>, <u>Emergency Procedures</u> and the <u>Waiver and Release of Liability</u> as well as signing it. So, now is a good time to remind everyone that by signing the <u>Waiver and Release of Liability</u> you are agreeing to; "I have read and understand the rules on all prior pages above and accept the responsibilities.", which is the second sentence in the first paragraph in the <u>Waiver and Release of Liability</u>. I bring this up because in the recent past we have had a couple of safety violations on the range that would indicate that either; 1) the individual didn't remember what they had read, or 2) didn't care about what they had read. Either way their actions resulted in a safety violation. Not having a full time RSO on the range requires a little more forethought and diligence from you the members in order to keep things safe out there. Knowing and applying the range/safety rules for yourself, guests and other members who may have forgot or didn't know is the most important way to keep things safe on the range. Remember when you are on the range you are an RSO.

NEW CLUB DUES - Effective June 2019-2020 year, BTRPC club dues will be \$100 plus \$5 for the gate key. Dues will be prorated for <u>new members only</u> from January 1 to June 30 at a rate of \$55. Renewal members pay the full annual rate regardless of when they pay their renewal.

<u>CLUB OFFICER ELECTIONS</u> – Elections for club officers for the 2019 – 2020 membership year will be held at the June General Membership meeting. You must be present and a member in good standing in order to vote.

<u>RULE REITERATION</u> – No rifles, shotguns, or pistols chambered for rifle or shotgun rounds, may be discharged at the pistol range. These rounds do way too much damage to the berm.

<u>SUMMERFEST</u> – The SUMMERFEST raffle rifle, and the raffle knife (custom made by Walt Heller) are on display at Wesley's Trading Post. Tickets are \$1 each, or 6 for \$5. There is a limit of 1100 tickets to be sold, better get them early. The rifle is Mossberg Patriot chambered in 6.5 Creedmore with a 3x9 Leupold VXII scope mounted.
